| Page v | The title of Chapter 6 is "Selection Games" |
| Page 32 | Question 1, answer choice (D) should be: Sonia, Paolo, Terrence, Raul, Terrence |
| Page 58 | Questions 1-6, the last condition should be: Tom must be placed to the immediate right of Henry, unless Susie is placed to the left of Henry. |
| Page 93 | Questions 1-5, the first condition should be: If more than one forward is selected, then exactly one center is selected. |
| Page 184 | The correct answer to question 2 is B (as it states in the explanation). |

The answer explanation for question 2 should read:

2. E

Note that the question doesn't ask what **COULD** be true; it asks what **MUST** be true. From your deductions, you know that Roselyn must represent team v; therefore, (E) is the correct answer. If Roselyn didn't represent team v, there would have to be seven lanes to separate Roselyn from team y, and team y from team v, (R ___ y ___ v). Since there are only six lanes, this is not possible.
