page 324, Question 17, Practice Test 1	<p>Question stem should begin with the following statement:</p> <p>Every student graduating from Burgerville College is either a 4-year student or a transfer student.</p>
page 333, Answer 17, Practice Test 1	<p>The answer is Choice 2.</p> <p>Paragraph 2 should read as follows:</p> <p>If we let x be the number of 4-year students graduating with honors, then the number of transfer students graduating with honors must be 50 percent greater than x; in other words, x plus $0.5x$, which is $1.5x$.</p> <p>The total number of students who graduate with honors is $1.5x$ plus x equals $2.5x$. Then the fraction of students who graduate with honors who are transfer students is $1.5x$ divided by $2.5x$ equals 1.5 divided by 2.5. There is no need to simplify this fraction. Statement (2) is sufficient.</p>
